Wednesday, June 30

2 Kings 5:13-18

After his miraculous healing, Naamun had a new desire to respect God in the way he would carry out his duties for the king. What ethical dilemmas do you face at work? From whom do you seek guidance and advice?

Thursday, July 1

Luke 16:10-15

Money is a strong motivator for work in our culture. What situations and attitudes draw you towards serving money? What situations and attitudes draw you towards serving God?

Friday, July 2

Mark 4:26-27

Timothy Keller likens all work to cultivating a garden; “like rearranging [God’s] raw material for the purpose of human flourishing.” In what ways do you see God’s purposes in the various kinds of work you do?

Saturday, July 3

Psalms 145:1-6

The most valuable work of all is accomplished by God himself. Where have you seen God at work in your world this past week? How has he invited you into what he is doing and what is your response?
