Sunday, August 22

Matthew 6:19

Monday, August 23

Matthew 6:20

What are you doing each day to store up treasures in heaven? What and who are these treasures?

Tuesday, August 24

Matthew 6:21

Be honest with yourself. Where is your heart, your time, your money, your influence truly invested? How does that align with what you say you believe?

Wednesday, August 25

Matthew 6:22; Matthew 26:11

Good eyes have a singular focus. While we can become overwhelmed with the world's unending need, our singular focus on Christ guides how we serve Him with our life and resources. On what are your "eyes" focused? How does that help or hinder your life as a disciple of Christ?

Thursday, August 26

Matthew 6:23; James 2:14-16

When we believe that our blessings and provisions belong to us, darkness enters into us. How does your ability to faithfully follow Christ get challenged when the topic is money?

Matthew 6:24; Matthew 19:21-30
